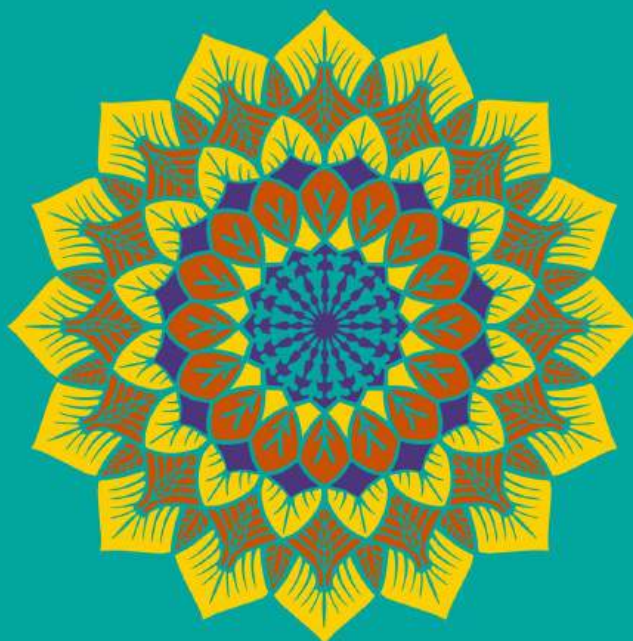

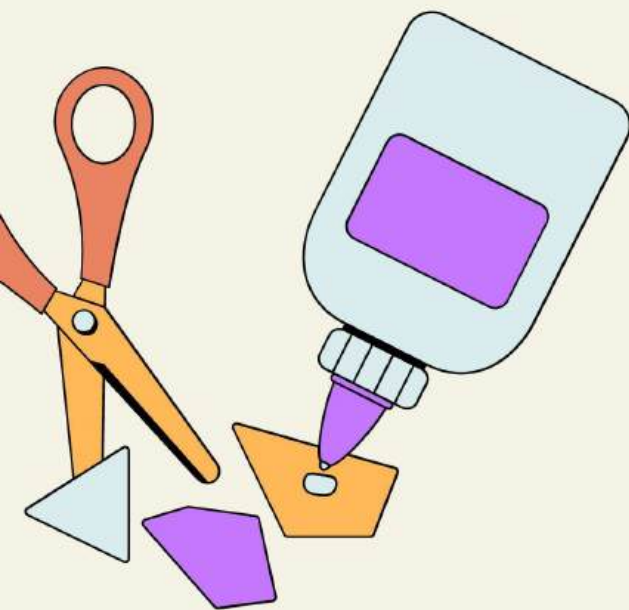
3.1 Wall Paper Craft Competition. Date of the Event- October 8, 2024

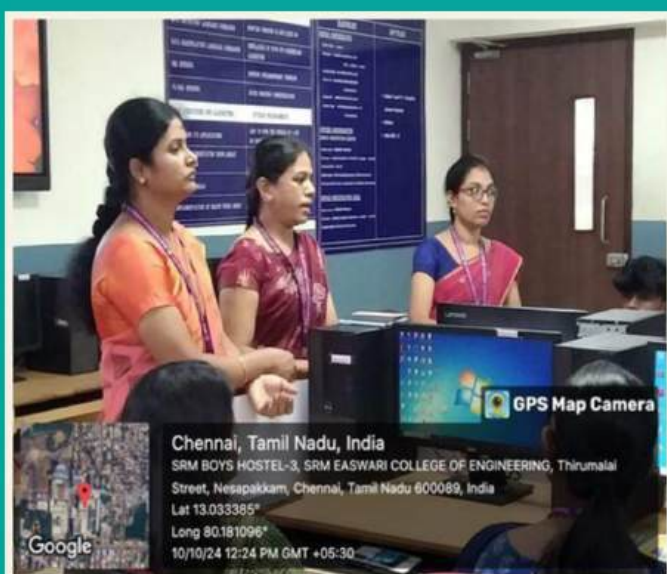
3.2 Skill Development Programme on Mastering the Microsoft Office: Word, Excel and Beyond.

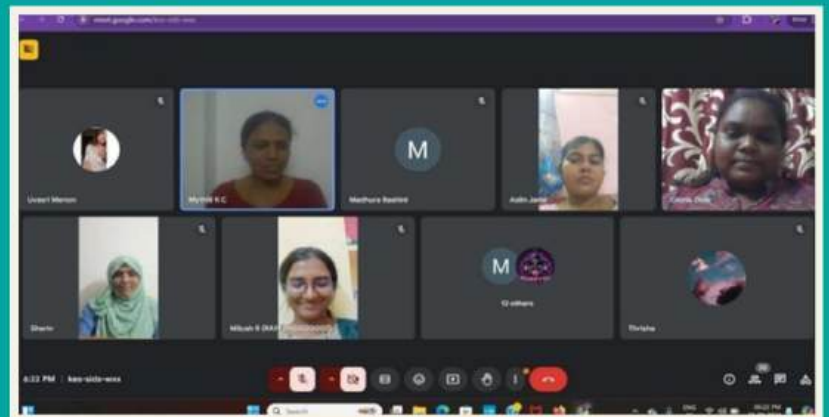

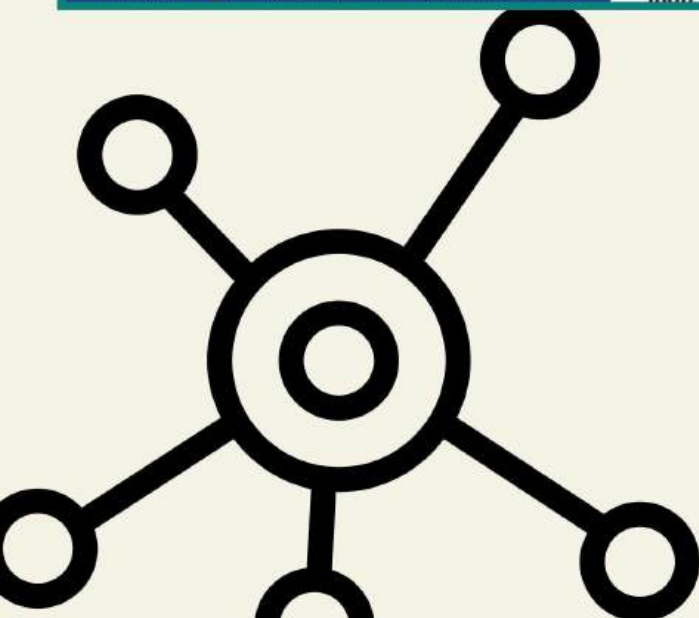

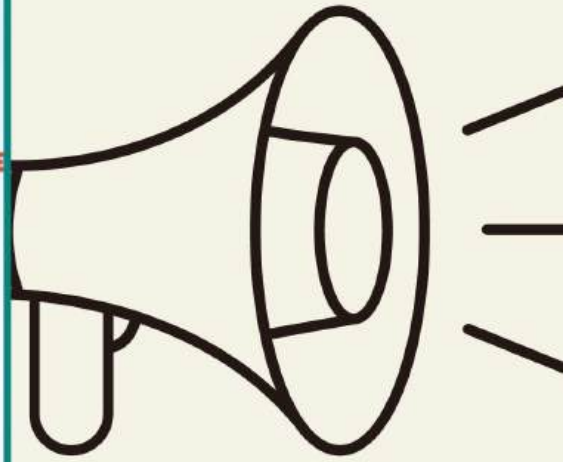
3.12 SHORT STORIES: THE POWER TO SPEAK THE UNSPEAKABLE

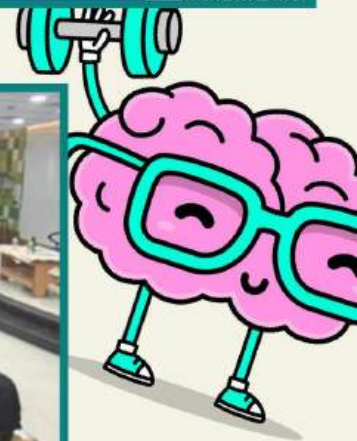


3.16 Motivation Talk on Personality Development through Habit Formation

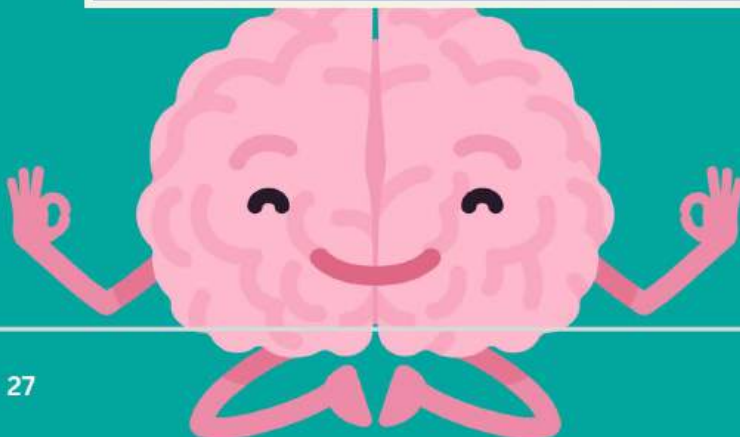
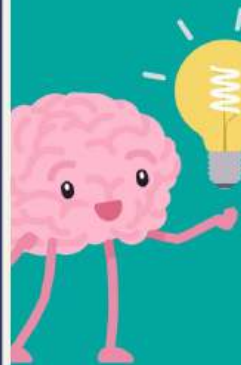

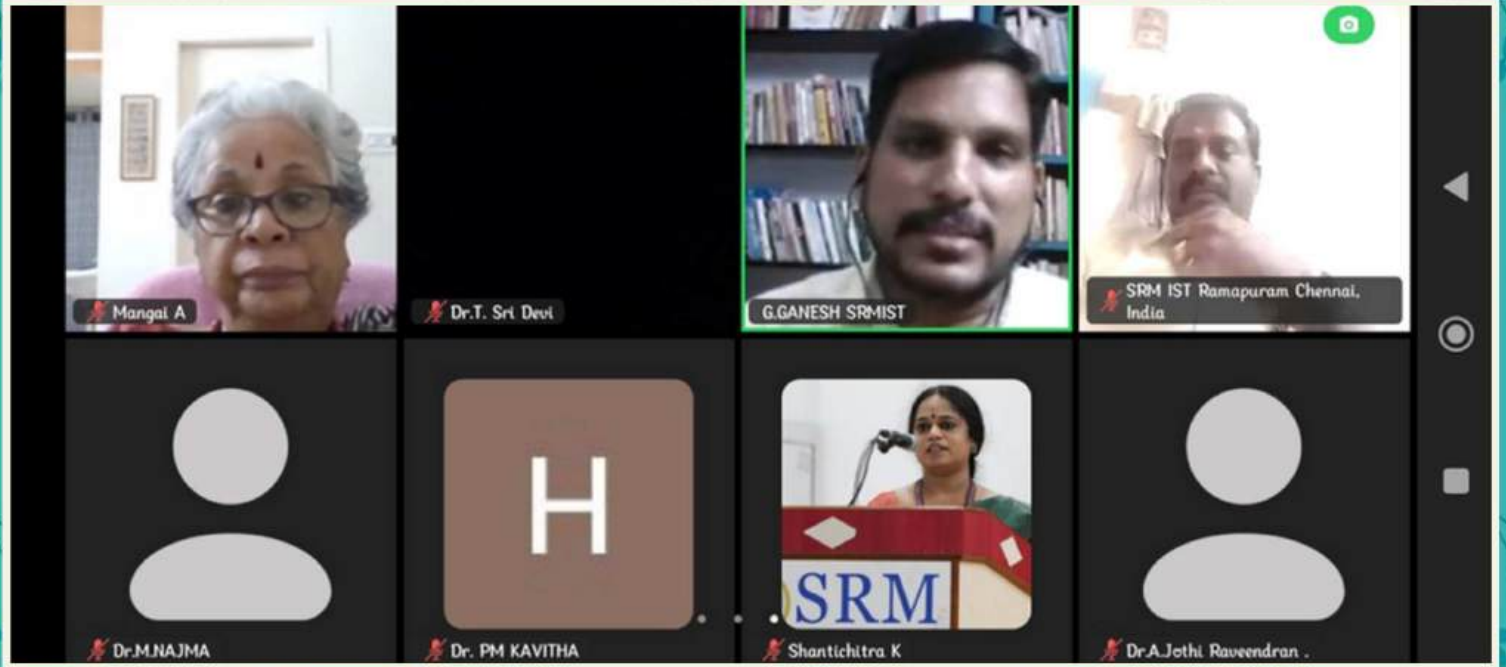
